WARRIORS ON TOP IN VALLEY CLASH

Warriors beat the San Fernando State Valley Frosh, 84-72 in a fast moving basketball clash at El Camino Dec. 10.

Still in the process of picking the right men for his squad, coach George Stanfich, with many new faces up for positions, has a chore on his hands.

Import roundballers from Glendale City College and Santa Barbara High show great promise for the ECC team. Forward, Clark Canfield, 6-2 and 175 in weight is a transfer from GCC with nine points to his credit in the contest, placed him as fourth top scoring man. Guard, Bob Garcia, S.B. High transfer, 5-9 150 High transfer, 5-9 150 pounds, virtually a one-man team, did not warm up until the second half to score 13 points all toll.

High score man for Camlino, center Jim Lloyd (from Aviation), 6-5 197 pounds racked up 21 points and number 58 guard, Kirk Brown (from El Segundo) 6-1 175 pounds placed second with 16.

Three minutes into the first half found the Warriors ahead with seven points, but the Matadors soon organized their bearings to comeback from behind and at one point were ahead by four.

Matador's most anxious fighter was forward, Bill Archer, 6-5 190 pounds who led his team all the way with 28 points.

This marks the fifth non-conference meeting for the EC squad. Standings thus far: Santa Ana 67, EC 75; Orange Coast 101, EC 74; Harbor City, 79, EC 77; Compton 96, EC 73; and Valley Frosh 72, EC 84.

MOUNT EVEREST CONQUEROR LECTURES IN SOUTHLAND

Luther G. (Lute) Jerstad, one of the few men who conquered lofty Mt. Everest is due to deliver two lectures in the Southland immediately after the first of the year.

Jerstad, appearing at Santa Monica Civic Aud., Jan. 7 and at Pasadena Civic Aud., Jan. 9, will tell of his experiences as a member of one of the three teams which climbed the "Roof of the World" with the 1963 American Mount Everest Expedition. Concerts, Inc. is sponsoring the adventurer's lecture dates.

Jerstad, a brilliant speaker, is a speech instructor at the University of Oregon. A graduate in theatre and speech from Pacific Lutheran University, Jerstad holds a Master's degree in theatre and speech from Washington State University.

He is widely known as a basketball player and a

member of the championship Pacific Lutheran University cage teams of 1954 to 1958 which played in three national tournaments.

Jerstad, along with his teammates on the Mt. Everest Expedition, received the National Geographic Society's famed Hubbard Medal from the hands of the late President John Fitzgerald Kennedy at the White House on July 8, 1963. The Hubbard Medal has been awarded to such heroes in the past as Admiral Byrd, Charles Lindberg, Colonel John Glenn and Amelia Earhart.
