## New Lomita Streets Get Board Okay

Plans for streets serving 23 new homesites in a tract located near Lomita Boulevard and Walnut Street have been approved by the Board of Supervisors.

Supervisor Burton W. Chace said the subdivider will pay the \$19,600 costs.

A \$4,000 allocation for the improvement of Bland Place and Pacific Coast Highway was approved, and a \$1,100 appropriation for work on Eshelman Avenue near 250th Street was voted.


