

Exhaust Control Progress Made

A major breakthrough in automobile exhaust control has been achieved with the announcement by four car manufacturers that they will have control systems meeting California standards on 1966 model cars.

This advance by a year the date originally designated by Detroit for installation of their exhaust systems on automobiles.

General Motors, Ford, Chrysler and American Motors told the California Motor Vehicle Pollution Control Board at a recent public meeting that they have stepped up testing of their systems and now believe it is possible to install them on practically all 1966 models, after State approval.

THE GENERAL Motors and Ford systems work on the principle of forcing air into the exhaust manifold to complete combustion of unburned gasoline and carbon monoxide. The Chrysler "Cleaner Air Package" modifies engine design to prevent formation of excessive hydrocarbons and CO. All would be for factory installation on new cars only.

William Nissen, MVPCB chairman, hailed the announcements as a "tremendous achievement in smog control that will be of great benefit to the people of California."

Examinations for California employment security program jobs will be held Aug. 20 and 21.

A year's service as a trainee allows an employe to take a promotional examination as journeyman employment security officer or disability officer with a beginning salary of \$536 and a top salary of \$619.


