

Garden Checklist

1. Plant sweet peas before the end of the month if you want blooms by Christmas.
2. Get an early start on the chrysanthemum season by setting out blooming plants from the nursery available now in containers.
3. Many vegetables may be planted this month for fall-winter harvest. Check with your local C.A.N. nurseryman.
4. Feeder roots of most shrubs are not near the trunk but out around the so called "drip line." Remember this when using plant food and watering.
5. Clay pots dry out less quickly if you double pot them. Use a larger pot outside the smaller one which holds the plant.
