(Continued from Page 1) the scene the aircraft was burning and numerous bystanders had gathered to watch. More police units soon arrived and the area was blocked off but there was traffic congestion in the surrounding area.  
Police said the aircraft was so badly destroyed only the last two digits and last letter of the airplane's identifying markers were visible.  
The airplane came to rest against a brick retaining wall. One of the craft's wings landed in the back yard of a home at 440 Camino De Encanto. Power lines were torn down by the plane. A crane and truck was dispatched from the Torrance airport to remove the airplane and debris.

Another witness, Richard Huxley of 444 Camino De Encanto, said he "saw the airplane heading straight down in a north angle, spinning and then crash into the block wall." Huxley said he heard the airplane's engine running up to the time of impact.  
Ester Lee of 436 Camino De Encanto said she heard what sounded like a low flying airplane. She looked out the window of her home and saw the airplane strike the power lines and crash.  
Howard J. Meyer, 49, of 520 Camino De Encanto, said he was on his front lawn when he saw "the airplane go into a roll mixed with low clouds. It came out of the first roll and went into another, nosing into the crash."
