## El Camino Instructor Sets Beethoven Sonata Recitals

Dr. Robert Haag, a music instructor at El Camino College, will present 32 Beethoven piano sonatas in a series of seven recitals at the El Camino campus theater.

The recital series will begin Sept. 18 at 8:30 p.m. Other performances will follow on Sept. 25, Oct. 2, 9, 16, 23, and 30. There will be no admission charge for the recitals.

"The Beethoven piano sonatas as a group are probably the most significant single contribution to the piano literature," Dr. Haag commented.

He has been preparing the recitals for almost a year. Dr. Haag's series will represent the third in which Beethoven's sonatas have been performed in Los Angeles. Other recitals in the cycle were by Richard Buhlig, Dr. Haag's teacher, in 1944, and by Lillian Stuber at the University of Southern California in 1946.
