Residents of the Southwest area will no longer have to go to UCLA to obtain information about the University of California Extension.

Extension offices are now open at 3620 B W. 182nd St. at North High School, Richard Guengerich, University Extension area representative and North High principal, said the office was opened in January because of increased population growth in the area.

Polio Shots Required For Admission to Classroom

Superintendent of Schools, Jack P. Crowther reminded parents this week that youngsters must be immunized against polio before they can be enrolled in classes when school opens on Monday.

The requirement, which is in compliance with state law, will affect more than 780,000 pupils who will enter the Los Angeles City Schools this fall, the superintendent said.

This particularly affects all new kindergarten enrollees, all transfers at any levels, including junior colleges, and all pupils entering a school for the first time.

New students must have at least one dose of polio vaccine prior to enrollment for the fall semester or have on file with the school a statement that immunization is contrary to belief or doctor's advice.

Students who have been enrolled that have not completed the series are required to have further immunization before returning to school.

Harriett B. Randall, M.D., director of the city schools health services branch, reported three Salk-type polio shots or the required Sabin oral vaccine doses are needed to satisfy immunizing requirements.

The superintendent urged all parents or guardians who are in doubt about the requirements to contact their local school.

Dr. Randall emphasized polio immunization is available from family physicians or Los Angeles County Health Department district offices.

Navy Reserve School Plans Counterinsurgency Course

With the addition of new courses in counterinsurgency and oceanography, the Naval Reserve Officers School 11-4 will offer the most comprehensive curriculum in its history this fall.

The new additions were announced by Capt. Harry B. Fishman, commanding officer of the school. The school serves reserve officers of the Navy in the Santa Ana, Long Beach, and Harbor areas.

Classes begin Thursday and will be held weekly each Tuesday and Thursday evening at the Santa Ana Reserve Training Center, Long Beach State College, and the Terminal Island Reserve Training Center.

In addition to the two new courses, the school will offer a full curriculum of Industrial College and Navy War College courses. Many classes in space technology, missiles, and international relations also will be scheduled.

All of the courses provide for full promotion and retirement credit. Information is available from the school by calling HE 9-6015.

All three new students are freshmen.


