

Two Area Students Plan Trip

Two area students were among 260 students selected this summer to participate in a program of foreign study under the sponsorship of the University of California.

Linea Barvin Hileman, of 17026 Yukon Ave., a student at the University of Riverside campus, will spend the coming year at a study center in Goettingen, Germany.

Glenn Edward Moore, of 15232 Purche Ave., and a student at the Santa Barbara campus of the University, also will spend his academic year in Goettingen.

BOTH STUDENTS will study at George August University, one of four centers established by the University of California through a cooperative foreign study program. Other centers are located at the University of Bordeaux, France; the University of Madrid, Spain, and the University of Padua, Italy.

The students were selected from applicants enrolled at the University campuses at Berkeley, Davis, Riverside, Santa Barbara, or Los Angeles. All have maintained superior academic standing. The participating students will get full University credit for courses taken while abroad.

Students will have every opportunity to assimilate the new culture by attending classes and living with resident students at the centers.
