### Leif Erikson's Day Will Be Celebrated Saturday

A dinner and dance Saturday celebrating Leif Erikson's Day, will have a very special meaning. President Lyndon B. Johnson signed officially a resolution for the permanent establishment of a Leif Erikson Day, in recognition of the Norseman who first explored the North American Continent, about the year A.D. 1000.

Dr. O. G. Landsverk in collaboration with the Leif Erikson Association of Los Angeles, labored long to achieve this recognition. Many Scandinavian fraternal organizations gave their time and efforts as well as Dr. Helge Ingstad, of Oslo, Norway, supported by the National Geographical Society, proved that Vikings did explore the shore of Newfoundland about A.D. 1000.

The Leif Erikson's Association will gather at the Elks Temple, 607 S. Parkview St., in Los Angeles for a 6 p.m. dinner, program, and dancing. George Nilson, a prominent Los Angeles attorney, will give the formal address.

MRS. GUDRUN Rhyning, popular singer of Scandinavian songs will also entertain. Evert Fahlstrom, emcee of the Scandinavian radio broadcasts will be master of ceremonies. He will also introduce William Thompson, renowned for his wit and fun when he speaks. Music for dancing will be provided by Willy's Orchestra.






