

Skipperette Selected for 1964 Fishermen's Fiesta

Cathi Villich, 17, was selected unanimously as Skipperette of the 1964 Fishermen's Fiesta from a group of seventeen contestants, in a contest-cruise aboard the "Angel's Gate" in Los Angeles Harbor.

The San Pedro miss will reign over the 14th annual festival of the nation's largest fishing fleet at the Port of Los Angeles, Oct. 23-25.

Runners-up in the contest, who will serve as Mates to the Skipperette, were Luana Madrid, 17, and Suzanne Butler, 16, both of San Pedro.

HEADING THE judging committee were Madlyn Rhue television and film actress, and Bruce Yarnell, singing star of the movie "Irma La Douce" and one-time bait boy aboard the fishing boat "Advance." Other members of the judging panel were Tony Young, star of Universal Pictures; Carol Crawford, director of the John Roberts Powers School, Long Beach; Roy Katnic, manager of the Fishermen's Cooperative Association, and John Evich, captain of the fishing boat "Cape Claire."

During the afternoon harbor cruise, contestants competing for the Skipperette title were judged on the basis of poise, beauty, and personality.

SKIPPERETTE Cathi is a dark-haired beauty with "changing" blue-green eyes. She has just begun her senior year at Mary Star of the Sea High School.

Cathi keeps her trim 36", 23", 36" measurements by skiing, riding, swimming, and playing volleyball at the beach. She plans to do fashion modeling and continue her education toward becoming a social director aboard an ocean liner, because she "likes boats and people."

A member of a family long associated with the fishing industry, Cathi proudly states that her grandmother, Mrs. Dobra Villich, "has worked in the tuna industry for more than 40 years." Steve Villich, her cousin, owns and operates five fishing boats, including the "Marcia Ann."

CATHI HAS a twin sister, Donna, and an older sister, Theresa. Luana Madrid's exotic beauty, a legacy of her Filipino-Hawaiian-Portuguese background, gained her sufficient votes to make her a Skipperette's Mate in a close-run contest.

LA Student Tours Bell Laboratory

A budding young student scientist from Los Angeles had the chance to exchange ideas with a world authority in his field at Pacific Telephone as part of the Future Engineers Program sponsored by the 1964 annual Western Electronic Show and Convention.

Martin A. Folb, 17, whose gas laser exhibit at the convention won first prize over 27 other electronics exhibits by outstanding students from eight western states, met with Dr. Eugene Gordon of Bell Laboratories.

Dr. Gordon is responsible at Bell for development of gas lasers, which allow communication over a beam of light. He has been a pioneer in laser development since 1961.

He congratulated Folb on the youth's achievement as all 28 students participating in the Future Engineers Program visited the telephone company.

HIGHLIGHT of their visit was a lecture-demonstration by Dr. Gordon in which he used a working model of a

laser and fielded questions from the students.

Folb, built his laser and worked out new methods of modulating it while a senior at Fairfax High School; he will attend the California Institute of Technology.

He and the other future engineers also toured Pacific's advanced communications complex at 434 S. Grand Ave. Its main switching center is the largest in the world. The tour gave the students a behind-the-scenes view of the communications industry.
