The program provides a solution to the individual economic hardships of area property owners.

The program provides a development of an industrial complex in the area.

"The only other alternative," Ferraro said, "is for the city to put up all the cash and we just can't do it."

COUNCILMEN and other city officials envision an industrial complex on the property, operated under a leasing system similar to that under which the Rolling Hills Plaza has been developed under commercial leases.

To carry out the program, councilmen will have to form

a local agency to supervise the project. The council may appoint itself as the local agency, or name a special board. In either event, development of the area is a local project, according to Rex Vance, representing the PHHFA.

Vance said a planner from his San Francisco office has inspected the site and already qualified most of it for the program. He also told councilmen the federal government was anxious to assist in the redevelopment of the area.

DURING A discussion on the ramifications of the project, J. B. Mosley, speaking for property owners in the area, asked Vance what would happen to the program should California adopt Proposition 14 in November.

(Federal Housing Director Robert C. Weaver said Monday the state might lose federal funds in the ballot measure is approved.)

Vance hedged on the question, then said the government would require a non-discrimination clause in the program.

COUNCILMAN Ross A. Sciarrotta Sr. said he would go along with the program "because of its nature." Sciarrotta said he was opposed to federal aid in most circumstances, then added, "If they have so much money, why not leave it here in the first place?"

Councilmen adopted the recommendation on a 5-0 vote. H. T. "Ted" Olson and George Vico were absent.
