Belts can always be depended upon to add a stimulating note to men's fashions, according to the American Institute of Men's and Boys' Wear and this fall is no exception to that rule.

Considering the relatively small area in which they have to work, it is a constant source of wonder how the belt stylists cram so much imaginative design into that limited space. The razzle-dazzle of belt styling sometimes concentrates on the buckles, at others on the leathers and fabrics. This season is one which gives the play to leathers and fabrics;

and smart buckle styling is evident.

For those who still think of belts as offering a choice of black or brown in calfskin or harness leather, a fast rifle through the nearest men's store belt rack will turn up some surprises. For instance, in addition to the familiar standbys, he will find exotic tannages of buffalo, kangaroo, ostrich and high-luster alligators. The latter have become great favorites with the Natural-Shoulder set as well as with the Contemporary crew.

THERE ARE also new and good looking suedes, chamois,

buffed calfs and shrunken grains. While on the subject of grains, there are Scotch grains trimmed with smooth calfs to exactly match the very popular new versions of saddle shoes. Also among the new fashion treatments given to belts this fall are "leather-on-leather" effects with a strip of contrasting hide either inserted or superimposed on the belt, woven leathers, combinations of varied leathers and a strong revival of lighter colored leathers.

Fabric belts aimed at use with casual suits and slacks include tweeds of varied patterns, elastics with comfort-loaded s-t-r-e-t-c-h and smartly colored regimental stripes.

Freeway Unsafe For Pedestrian

A study of accidents involving pedestrians on freeways recently completed by the California Division of Highways proved one-third of the annual 130 such accidents involved individuals who set out across the path of oncoming traffic.

The study, which includes a five-year period beginning in 1958, proves conclusively that a freeway is no place to be on foot if avoidable. The annual average of 130 pedestrian accidents included 55 fatalities and walkers were a factor in 13 per cent of all fatal freeway accidents.

ALMOST half of the victims, 43 per cent, became freeway pedestrians following breakdown of their vehicles or involvement in a prior ac-

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
