

Student at South Cited

Anina Schwartz has received a special award in science from the Medalist Award Program, held at the Union Oil Center in Los Angeles. The program is sponsored by the Southern California Science Industry-Education Council. Miss Schwartz was one of 150 high school students in Los Angeles County selected to receive the award. A student at South High, Miss Schwartz is now considering matriculation at Pomona College, the University of California at Berkeley, or Stanford University. Classroom Has Unique Study Plan

Mrs. Carmen Bostic is an average seventh grade teacher at Anza Elementary School, but she has turned her classroom into something more than average. Mrs. Bostic teaches history in a departmentalized classroom, and she has students in the class making some unusual things—mummies, clay tablets, and pyramids!

State law has decreed that seventh grade students must go into ancient history in greater depth than ever before, so Mrs. Bostic decided she could use the students' research skills to best advantage by producing some visible results.

The class may have solved one of the great mysteries of ancient history, too. During the study of pyramids, the students began to wonder how the ancients built their great pyramids. Well, if built by the class, the pyramids would have taken 100,000 slaves to build. The slaves would have hauled the great rocks up an inclined road by barge.

The state textbook, introduced this fall in the schools, presents the history of the Mediterranean area and the Middle East, emphasizing the contributions of early civilizations.

The study is divided into a 10-week pre-feudal period, after which students get into European history. The remainder of the course is devoted to a study of current problems in the Mediterranean, Middle East, and European countries.

The purpose of the pro-

gram is to give the students an insight into the contributions of ancient civilizations and some idea of the influence of those contributions on today's nations. Material taught in the seventh grade is reviewed again in the tenth grade in preparation for a more thorough study in high school.


