Nursery School Class Hears of Fire Safety

A 3-year-old child can be taught to walk, not run, to the nearest exit in case of fire. So learned mothers and children at the Torrance Cooperative Nursery, a unique pre-school which educates the parents as well as the children. At a recent training session for mothers, John McBride of the Redondo Beach Fire Department, explained what to do if a fire should begin. McBride demonstrated the use of extinguishers, outlined evacuation plans, and emphasized the need for fire drills. To impress upon each child the need to leave matches

alone, McBride deputized each child and outfitted them with badges and caps. McBride had a special reason for teaching fire safety at the school—he has a youngster enrolled.


