

Veterans To Attend Memorial

World War II veterans from the Southwest area will be well represented at the fourth annual Pearl Harbor Day Memorial dinner Monday, according to John W. Taylor, chairman of the Torrance-Gardena-South Bay Veterans Employment Committee.

Marshall Miller, chief of the Veterans Employment Service, U.S. Department of

Labor, will be the principal speaker at the dinner to be held in the Los Angeles Furniture Mart, 1933 S. Broadway at 7 p.m. He will stress the need to utilize the highest skills of living veterans as the best memorial to the 2,400 Americans who died at Pearl Harbor, according to Taylor.

Master of ceremonies will be D. Patrick Ahern, col-

lector of customs of the Los Angeles district, who is active in veterans' welfare work.

"Veterans Employment Committees are composed of representatives of the various veterans' organizations and act as advisory groups to the California State Employment Service in its effort to find jobs for qualified vet-

erans," continued Taylor. Dinner reservations are available through Ben Viney at OR 8-2541.

'Handicap' Contest Open To Students

High school students in the South west area have been invited to participate in a report writing contest by the Torrance Community Committee for Employment of the Physically Handicapped, in cooperation with the Califor-

nia State Employment Service.

Title of the contest is "Ability Counts" and the theme is "How the Handicapped are Overcoming Barriers to Employment in My Community."

Open to all juniors and seniors in every high school in the country, prizes will be awarded on the local, state, and national level. Awards will range from \$25 Savings Bonds to a \$1,000 cash prize.

The top California award is an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., plus \$100 cash.

Deadline for submission of entries is Dec. 23, according to John E. Sullivan of the Torrance office of the California State Employment Service. Selection of judges is now in progress and their names will be announced shortly, continued Sullivan.
