## Registration Set for Area Adult School

Registration for second semester classes at Narbonne Adult School will begin on Jan. 18. Counselors will be on duty each school day evening to advise and assist persons who wish to plan courses to obtain a high school diploma.

Classes will be offered in business, trade, and industrial courses also, many of which actually result in job up-grading and better job opportunity for adult students making satisfactory progress.

All classes taught in the adult school program give credit toward a high school diploma, except English for the foreign speaking, and citizenship. These two are preparation both for high school work and citizenship by naturalization.

## Hahn Says Anti-Smog Device NG

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn said today it is "financially unsound" to force nearly four million motorists to purchase a \$50 to \$75 crankcase blow-by device to control smog from the motor vehicle.

Instead, Hahn, said, the Detroit automobile manufacturers should assume—or be required to assume—their rightful responsibility in equipping each car with an effective exhaust device.

This can be done, he said, by action of Congress and the Interstate Commerce Commission requiring vehicles have an adequate device before being shipped across state lines.

In 1955, engineers from General Motors, Chrysler, and Ford Motor Co. told me there is a device available that would cost only from \$10 to \$15 and would solve the air pollution problem," Hahn said.

"I do not know why the industry has been reluctant to equip motor vehicles with the device, not only for cars sold in California, but everywhere in the United States," he added.

"IT WILL BE an impossible, mechanic's nightmare to require the present automobile owners to go to their service stations or garages and buy a device," he added.

"A reasonable approach is to require a used car dealer before the automobile is sold from the lot, to equip it with an approved device. Not all of the cars have to be equipped at once."

## Armament Contract Awarded

A production contract calling for armament pylons for McDonnell Aircraft Corp.'s "Phantom" has been awarded to Aeronca Manufacturing Corp. by the St. Louis based firm.

The \$7.2 million contract will run through 1966 with production to start immediately, according to S. J. Kuderer, Aeronca president.

The "Phantom" is a twin-engine tactical fighter-bomber used by the Air Force. Production work on the contract will be done at the Torrance facility.
