

Pacific Telephone Sets Plans for Construction

Pacific Telephone Co. plans to spend more than \$445 million in construction during 1965, according to Carl O. Lindeman, president of utility company.

"We are planning expenditures of this magnitude in the face of the order of the California Public Utilities Commission which proposes to cut our rates," Lindeman said.

"However, if we are to meet our commitments to our customers," he added, "we must gear our plans to keep pace with California's growth insofar as we are able."

The firm plans to invest \$153 million in new central office equipment and \$28 million for land and buildings. Other budgeted items include \$89 million for new cables, lines, and microwave facilities and \$175 million for new telephone switchboards, instruments, and other equipment.

Pacific Telephone Co. added 485,000 telephones in California during 1964 and now serves some eight million in the state, Lindeman said. Those eight million telephones carried a total of 9.4

billion local and long distance telephone calls during the year, a seven per cent increase over the previous year. The firm also was the largest

County to Help Vets On Forms

Disabled veterans and dependents of deceased vets were advised today that they may receive assistance in filling out the annual VA income questionnaire at the Long Beach and Compton branches of the County Service Office.

Supervisor Burton W. Chace announced that the questionnaires have been sent to approximately 50,000 disabled vets and to the dependents of 30,000 deceased vets in Southern California who are drawing non-service connecting pensions.

The VA pensioners are required to report all income received during 1964 and that expected in 1965. Payment of the pension depends on the amount of income and net worth of the pensioner.

CHACE explained that amendments to the pension law have caused several changes in determining annual income. For this reason he urged pensioners to consult with a veterans representative at the Long Beach or Compton offices in completing the questionnaire.

Increases in the monthly pension rates will go into effect in January, he added, and will be contained in checks received by Feb. 1.
