

PAR Shop Open to Retarded

Admission applications are being accepted at PAR Workshops Southwest, an occupational training and sheltered workshop program for mentally retarded adults, 16 years and over.

The workshop, located at 180th and Western avenues, Gardena, serves the Southwest-Centinel Valley area and is a cooperative effort of the Southwest Association for Retarded Children and the Exceptional Children's Foundation of Los Angeles.

Workshop trainees are instructed in such work as rebuilding used equipment, collating, mailer stuffing, assembling of electrical parts, hardware items and toys, and packaging the parts in plastic bags. Work, contracted from local industry, is brought in to the shop to be completed. Employment and training are provided daily from 8:30 to 4 p.m.

MODERATELY retarded persons are trained by the shop with the goal of engaging in outside competitive work. Training includes yard work, industrial cleaning, and light assembly jobs.

Retardates who are more severely handicapped may remain in a continuous workshop situation.
