

Torrance Doctor Joins New Area Heart Group

A Torrance cardiologist will play an instrumental role in bringing and promoting more heart health facts and care to the area, the Los Angeles County Heart Association disclosed today.

Dr. Ronald T. Piccirillo has joined key heart volunteers throughout the Southland in forming a new Heart Association executive board. The board was created to meet the increasing demands for heart health and educational programs on a "community level" in the 21 communities that comprise the Heart Association's Southwestern Branch.

The local doctor, newly-elected Southwestern Branch chairman, will be working with other heart leaders in designing and developing heart education and community service programs in the area which extends from Wilmington to Westchester.

Regarding the function of the new board, Dr. Piccirillo clarified that, "We expect to develop and have more heart health services for the individuals and communities throughout the branch."

"AT THE first meeting," he added, "initial plans for expansion of heart programs were discussed."

The board also approved a Queen of Hearts contest which will enable a high school girl closely associated with heart problems, personally or through her family, to be selected Heart Queen of Los Angeles County.

In the promotion, the doctor explained, the Southwestern Branch will be represented by a Heart Princess who will be picked in the next few months. Each community in the area will have a chance to find a candidate for the selection of the Southwestern Branch Heart Princess, he added.
