

Reading Program Based on Phonics at Calvary School

A modern system of phonics will be used to teach students to read at the Calvary Baptist Elementary School in Gardena, according to Lawrence J. Clark, principal of the school.

Children will begin kindergarten by learning the sounds of the consonants, Clark explained, as well as visual discrimination through exercises. The kindergarten students also will be exposed to creative language experiences.

In the first grade, children will learn the sounds of the vowels and memorize rules that tell which of the vowel sounds to use in a word.

"By the end of the first semester of first grade, the pupils are reading entirely by phonics," Clark said.

In the second and third grades, students are taught word-attack skills and assigned book reports to learn to read for enjoyment. Additional written assignments are given in the fourth, fifth, and sixth grades.

Adult School Will Teach Italian Here

Newest language offering of the Torrance Evening High School department of adult education this fall will be conversational Italian.

Meeting Tuesday evenings at 7 p.m. in Room K-3 at South High School, beginning Sept. 21, the class will be geared towards persons planning to visit Italy.

In addition to conversational instruction, the course will highlight the culture of the Italian people by featuring colored slides of the countryside. Sections of the mainland, Sicily and the smaller romantic isles such as Capri, will be included in the slide showings.

For the world traveler, special attention will be given to everyday expressions, the metric and money systems, signs, food and ordering, shopping and sightseeing.

Correct Italian pronunciation will be emphasized, and students will be given drill and translation "know-how". Written instruction will be limited to those students who wish to write the language.

Los Angeles Schools Seek Playground Aides for Area

Interested and qualified adults and college students are needed at Los Angeles City elementary schools this fall to work as nontime playground directors, according to Associate Superintendent Robert J. Purdy.

The directors provide nontime supervision of children in school cafeterias, outside eating areas, and on the school playgrounds under the direction of the principal.

College students, parents, and other qualified adults are asked to apply for these positions at local elementary schools.

Principals will interview applicants through Sept. 10, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. All schools will be closed on Sept. 6 and 9, which are legal holidays.

Successful applicants will be hired at the rate of \$2.40 per hour, and will begin work on Tuesday, Sept. 14, following a training program on Monday, Sept. 13. The number of noon duty playground directors at each school will depend on enrollment.
