

# Thomas Pledges Support For State College Site

"A state college to serve the South Bay is close to permanent reality," Assemblyman Vincent Thomas, D-San Pedro, said today.

"It is gratifying to see that the trustees have been able to move so rapidly in narrowing down the search for a permanent site to three potential locations, and I am hopeful that the final site can be adopted at their October meeting."

Thomas' remarks were occasioned by announcement that the architectural firm of Jones and Emmons, which has been retained by California State College trustees to prepare a report on the feasibility of all potential locations for homeless Palos Verdes State College, has recommended that in depth studies be made on three of the more than 40 locations that were considered.

"IF THE trustees can come up with a definite site prior to next February's budget session of the legislature, I will introduce legislation to appropriate funds to provide for the continued operation of the college in temporary quarters until a permanent campus can be built," Thomas said.

Thomas stated that he would also introduce an appropriation bill to provide for reasonable additional funds if that be required to purchase the selected site. Assemblyman Thomas was successful in gaining legislative and gubernatorial approval

for a \$50,000 appropriation permitting the college to enroll some 75 students in temporary quarters this coming school year.

"HOWEVER, unless a site is selected soon I doubt that any additional funds will be made available," Thomas stressed. "Furthermore, when the legislature appropriated \$5 million for site acquisition in 1962 it was intended that the college be located within the South Bay. Although I will support any location the trustees may select, I believe there is serious question of gaining legislative approval for any site outside the South Bay area."

"Through July of this year the State had already spent \$1,386,705 on the college," Thomas continued. "More than \$200,000 of that sum has been spent in attempted site acquisition, \$934,000 on staff payroll, operating expenses and equipment, and some \$245,000 for library books. In addition, \$457,997 was appropriated for support of the

college in fiscal year 1965-66. "We should not throw away the advantages that have been gained from the expenditure of almost \$2 million," Thomas concluded, "but we cannot continue to spend money without a permanent college."
