Beach Cities Ballet Company, one of 150 chartered regional ballet companies, now includes 25 dancers. Regional companies are supported by donations and sponsorships from residents of the community.

Sharon Wickstrom will be seen as Princess Aurora and Margit Ernst dances the role of Lilac Fairy. Lynn Cobale and Jon Simonson will perform parts of the Bluebirds, while the White Cat and "Puss-In-Boots" will be portrayed by Dianna Clanin and Richard Gordon. Louise Brown and Joe Oreskovich will dance the roles of Red Riding Hood and the Wolf.

In addition to their work with the beach cities company, the dancers have appeared with the New York City Ballet Company, the Long Beach Civic Light Opera Association, the Beach Cities Symphony, and the Bolshoi Ballet Company.

Choreography for "Sleeping Beauty" and the "Warsaw Concerto" was done by Barbara Simonson. Bill Roberts is choreographer for the jazz ballet.


