**National Merit Competition**  
**Eight Students Named**  
**On Semi-Finalist List**

Eight Southwest area high school students have been selected as semi-finalists in the annual competition sponsored by the National Merit Scholarship Corp., it was announced today.

The eight local students are among 14,000 national semi-finalists named today as results of the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test were announced. The semi-finalists are the highest-scoring students in each state.

Discussions about staging and programing in the proposed civic auditorium complex in Torrance will continue tomorrow evening when the Auditorium Advisory Committee meets.

J. B. Mosley, chairman of the citizens group, said a meeting will be held in the Torrance Recreation Center at 7:30. Representatives of the Footlight Theater will address the committee.

Also scheduled is a continuation of the discussion begun last week on parking. The committee is "preparing to recommend" that the proposed auditorium be located on the northwest corner of the civic center to achieve maximum parking facilities.

An architect also is scheduled to address the committee, Mosley said.

TO BECOME finalists, all eight students must substantiate their qualifying test performances on a second examination, submit recommendations by their schools, and fulfill routine requirements. All 1966 Merit Scholars will be selected from the finalist group.

Ambill plans to major in philosophy in college and hopes to become a writer. Miss McLaughlin will pursue pre-medical studies when she graduates from Redondo Union High School.

Redding and Lemke will major in physics in college, while Gerhardt and Leavitt plan to study engineering. Miss Stansbury plans to become an English teacher and Miss Phippen will study mathematics.

AT LEAST 97 per cent of past semi-finalists have become finalists in the National Merit competition. Finalists are eligible for four-year college scholarships sponsored by the National Merit Scholarship Corp., some 280 corporations, foundations, colleges, unions, trusts, professional organizations, and individuals.

Names of the Merit Scholars will be announced about April 27, 1966, according to John M. Stalnaker, president of the sponsoring corporation.
