Greek Festival Planned Here

St. Katherine Greek Orthodox Church of Redondo Beach will stage a "Greek Festival" at the Torrance Recreation Center Oct. 2 and 3. Mrs. Ernest Donlou, chairman of the festival, has announced.

Father Naoum Nitsiotis, pastor of St. Katherine's, and Mrs. Angelo Revels, president of the Ladies Philoptochos Society, hope to make the festival an annual affair.

Events will begin at 11 a.m. both days and end about 8 p.m., Mrs. Donlou said. Admission to the festival is free.

Highlights of the festival will include an appearance by the Athan Karras Dance Troupe in their Evzone costumes and a combination dinner which will include a variety of Greek foods. Several booths will be open throughout the festival.

Library Shows Minor Decline

The Torrance Library showed a decrease in book and magazine circulation in August of this year as compared to the same month in 1964. Circulation figures were 16,576 in 1964 and 15,950 in 1965.

The Los Angeles County Library System showed a slight over-all circulation gain this year of 17,041 over the volumes circulated during August of last year, according to County Librarian William S. Geller.

Efron Named Director of Union Hebrew High School

Benjamin Efron, a nationally known educator and author, has been named director of the Redondo Beach branch of the Union Hebrew High School. The school is now conducting classes at Temple Menorah, 1101 Camino Real.

Efron, who comes to the area from New York, was named by the Union of American Hebrew Congregations (UAHC) to head both the high school, which has branches throughout the Southland, and the UAHC College of Jewish Studies in Los Angeles.

The Redondo Beach classes are held at 4 p.m. Wednesdays and at noon on Saturdays. The high school, now

in its ninth year, is the first of its kind sponsored by the UAHC.

Efron is first vice president of the National Association of Temple Educators. He authored, with Rabbi Solomon Landman, "Story Without End," an informal history of the Jewish people.
