

Attorney General Names Obscenity Probe Group

California Attorney General Thomas C. Lynch today announced the appointment of an Advisory Committee on Obscenity as the first step in his statewide crackdown on obscene material.

The stepped-up activity against obscenity on the state level resulted from a \$50,000 appropriation by the 1965 Legislature. Lynch made his announcement at a Peace Officers meeting in Woodville, Calif. He said the step is part of the activity planned for the Criminal Justice Year which he announced last week. Following appointment of the Advisory Committee, a professional staff will be appointed, Lynch said.

The Attorney General's anti-obscenity program will involve:

- Investigation of the source of obscenity in California.
- Gathering data for use by the Legislature in drafting more effective anti-obscenity legislation.
- Assisting district attorneys and city attorneys in legal proceedings against pornography.
- Exploring possible civil legal actions which may be taken against purveyors of obscene material.

Ballantyne of Tulare County was named chairman of the group. Co-chairman is City Attorney Edward Butler of San Diego. Other members of the committee are District Attorney John Price of Sacramento County, District Attorney Keith Sorenson of San Mateo County, City Attorney Roger Arnebergh of Los Angeles, Sheriff Frank Madigan of Oakland, and Police Chief Earl Reinbold of Santa Monica.

The purpose of the crackdown will be primarily study and investigation rather than immediate prosecutions, Lynch emphasized. Prosecutions will be handled mainly by district attorneys and city attorneys backed up by the Attorney General and the facilities of the committee.

Torrance School Bonds Sold to Bank of America

Purchase of \$1 million in Torrance Unified School District Bonds by a Bank of America syndicate has been announced here.

The group submitted a low bid of 3.3530 per cent on the bonds, which mature over a 20-year period.

The bonds bear coupon rates of 4.5, 3.25, 3.30, and 3.40 per cent and have been re-offered to investors to yield from 2.5 per cent to a dollar price of par on the 3.40 per cent bonds, the bank said.
