## Chapel Theatre Stages 'Someone Waiting' Here

"Someone Waiting," a mystery by Emyln Williams, will open Oct. 29 at the Chapel Theatre in Torrance. The story involves the father of a boy who was hung for a murder he did not commit and tells of the father's attempt to seek vengeance for his son. Tony Baynes of Los Angeles, winner of the best director award at the Chapel Theatre 1964 season, directs the cast of old and new members of Chapel Theatre. Leading roles are played by Alan Sinclair of Los Angeles, and Joseph Reale of Los Angeles. Sinclair is seen as the father seeking vengeance, while

Reale plays the executed boy's best friend. Supporting members of the cast include Gladys Manu of Wilmington, Austin Rheingold of San Pedro, Pamela Deckett of Palos Verdes, Esther Drake of San Pedro, and Carol Hanson of San Pedro. ## Chalekson Appointed Principal

George Chalekson, vice principal of Fern-Greenwood Elementary School, has been appointed principal of Calle Mayor Elementary School, Dr. J. H. Hull, superintendent of schools, has announced. Chalekson succeeds Dr. Richard Welte, who has accepted a position as director of elementary education in the Downey Unified School District. Chalekson, a native of Detroit, graduated from Redondo Union High School in 1952. He received his bachelor's degree from the University of Southern California in 1958 and began his teaching career in Torrance the following September.

In 1962, after four years as a teacher at Seaside School, Chalekson became vice principal at Meadow Park School. He has served at Riviera and Anza schools in the same capacity. He received his master's degree from USC in 1963. Chalekson is married and the father of a two-week old daughter. He and his family reside in Palos Verdes Estates.

While attending Redondo Union High School, the new principal served on the student council and played basketball. He won the Lion Club's outstanding citizen award and also represented the school at the Boys' State convention.

DR. WELTE leaves the Torrance schools after 11 years as a vice principal and principal. He came to Torrance in 1954 as vice principal of Perry School. He also served at Crenshaw and Casimir schools in the same position. A graduate of the University of Southern California, Dr. Welte served five years as principal of Carr School before moving to Calle Mayor four years ago. He earned a doctorate in education at USC last year.
