

Plans Approved For Two Schools

Preliminary plans for two new Torrance elementary schools were approved Monday evening by the Board of Education and the architect was ordered to proceed with working drawings.

The new schools — one on Spencer Street in the Victor Precinct and one in Tract 2200 — will be designed to accommodate about 550 students each when they open, probably in February, 1967.

Estimated cost of the two schools is \$771,000 for the Tract 2200 construction and \$806,000 for the Spencer Street buildings.

BOTH SCHOOLS will have 16 classrooms, two kindergarten classrooms, administration buildings, and multi-purpose buildings. The Tract 2200 school, to be located near Madison Street south of 235th Street, will be one-story construction.

A two-story classroom building will be built on the Spencer Street site, which is located between Del Amo Boulevard and Spencer Street. Two-story construction is necessary because of a long, narrow site. Building will front on Spencer Street.

Work on both schools will be completed as fast as possible in order to relieve overcrowded classrooms in schools adjacent to the new sites.

DR. BERNARD GAREN, supervisor of construction for the school district, said the architects would have working drawings and specifications ready within five months. Construction will require about nine months.

In related actions Monday, trustees authorized Dr. Garen to employ LeRoy Crandall and Associates to conduct soil tests on both sites and

New Tract In Lomita Approved

Preliminary plans for a 212-home subdivision near Western Avenue and Palos Verdes Drive North in Lomita have been approved by the Lomita City Council.

Councilmen also voted to change the zoning of the 54-acre parcel to permit the construction of the hillside homes.

In approving the tentative tract map, councilmen imposed a long list of conditions. Two of the conditions recommended by the Lomita Planning Commission were altered by councilmen.

The council said developer Henry C. Griswold must construct a six-foot chain link fence along the northern boundary of the tract and landscape the entrance to the development with low shrubs. The entrance must be a 67-foot right-of-way dedicated to the city.

Griswold said he expects to begin construction of the 212 homes — which will be in the \$47,000 to \$56,000 range — in five or six months.

The initial plans are subject to possible revisions following a geological study of the area.
