Fall Concert Is Scheduled At El Camino

Classical music of traditional and modern motifs will be featured in the fall concert of the El Camino College orchestra Nov. 12, at 8 p.m. in the Campus Theater.

The annual concert is open to the public, without admission charge, as a gesture of appreciation to the community on behalf of the college music department. Conductor for the concert will be James Mack, El Camino music instructor.

The concert's selection will range from Purcell to Copland, highlighting Mozart's "Overture to the Magic Flute," Brahms' "Hungarian Dance Number 1," and Jacob's "Concertino for Piano and Orchestra."

Miss Loretta Nicassio will be the featured piano soloist for the evening.

Miss Nicassio, staff accompanist at El Camino, has appeared with the Beach Cities Symphony Orchestra, the men's glee club, the community choir and has played with and for various musical organizations on campus.

School Employees Seek Insurance Contribution

Implementation of a health insurance program partially financed by the Torrance Unified School District was asked by members of Local 1101 of the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees Monday evening.

Sam Hunnigs, representing the union, told trustees he would like to see the health insurance contribution initiated by the school district by the first of the year.

Such a program, Hunnigs said, would cover 590 non-teaching employees of the district. About 50 of the employees are part-time workers.

In a report on the health insurance program submitted to the board, Hunnigs said only four of the 24 districts to which Torrance is compared make no contribution to an employee insurance program. The average contribution of the 20 districts is \$7.04 per month, he added.

Hunnigs said Torrance employees hope to be treated "in a similar way."

Trustees agreed to study the material compiled by the union. When asked if they might be ready to give some indication at the Nov. 15 meeting, however, trustee William J. Hanson said he favored putting the matter off until the budget is considered next year.

"We would hope it would not be complicated by salary considerations," Hunnigs told Hanson.


