CAPT. JOHN I. HARDY To Speak Here

Navy Capt. John I. Hardy, commanding officer of the U. S. Naval Ordnance Test Station at China Lake, Calif., will address the Palos Verdes Peninsula Council of the United States tomorrow evening.

The meeting will be held at the Plush Horse Restaurant, according to Dr. Richard B. Hanchett, president of the Palos Verdes Peninsula Council. It will be open to women guests.

Bids for the improvement of the U.S. Post Office and Federal Building in Harbor City are being solicited by the San Francisco Regional Office of the General Services Administration (GSA).

The project includes the installation of a suspended ceiling, floor covering, and additional lighting. The construction of a mailing platform, extension of the air conditioning system, and interior painting are included in the plans.

A GRADUATE of the U.S. Naval Academy, Capt. Hardy received his master of science degree in aeronautical engineering from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. During World War II, he served on the cruiser USS Pensacola in the South Pacific.

Capt. Hardy served as naval aide to the Assistant Secretary of the Navy (Research and Development) and Commanding Officer of the USS Hornet. He assumed his present command in August, 1964.
