

High-Speed Trains Might Be 'Just Around Corner'

Super-speed rail travel in this country may be "just around the bend."

The Pennsylvania Railroad has just asked for bids for 50 passenger cars capable of operating at speeds of up to 160 miles an hour. Delivery of the cars is expected in the spring of 1967 for possible use in the busy New York-Philadelphia-Washington corridor.

This particular stretch, something more than 200 miles long, has a high volume of passenger travel and might to the best proving ground on which the railroads can make their bid to win back air travelers.

Meanwhile, in Japan new schedules have just been announced that will give that nation the world's fastest long-run trains. They have been operating at very high speeds for many months, but will run still faster now that the roadbed has settled.

BROWN EGGS GAIN FAVOR—Status has many symbols — cars, yachts, furs and such—but it has been a long time since rank was displayed by so humble an item as the egg. New sales figures from the poultry industry indicate that U. S. housewives have begun to hold the brown-shelled egg in extra-high regard.

Poultrymen are at a loss to explain in any other way a recent boom in the popularity of brown eggs. International poultry producer Donald McQ. Shaver, whose international egg research farms are located at Galt, Ontario, says brown eggs traditionally have been popular only in a small area of New England. But Shaver says new demands for the brown-shelled eggs are showing up in such widespread markets as Los Angeles and New York.

He says, "Somehow, it appears, the brown egg has become a status thing."

Shell color makes little difference, Shaver says, in egg quality for the contents are the same. But for breeders like himself the new trend poses a challenge to supply those markets with economical brown-egg-laying hens.

BITS O' BUSINESS—Dividend increases at year-end are rising in number — increases in October were the highest on record for that month. The General Motors year-end dividend of \$2.25 brings the company's total to \$1.495 billion a year, a record for any company. Consumer installment credit in September rose by \$683 million, are largest increase since the record rise in April.
