**Japanese Doctor Given Grant for New Studies**

A possibility that racial factors may account for sharp differences in Japanese and American death rates for leukemia, lymphoma, and Hodgkin's disease will be investigated at the University of Southern California by a Japanese scientist, Haruki Wakasa, M.D., under a two-year Darnham Junior fellowship award from the California Division of the American Cancer Society.

The \$17,000 grant was announced today by Lewis W. Guiss, M.D., of Los Angeles, the Society's state president. Dr. Guiss also announced the award of a \$109,840 five-year Darnham senior fellowship to David Mitchell Brown, M.D., for endocrine studies at the University of California Medical School in Los Angeles.

Dr. Wakasa's studies will be based on the observation that death rates of whites and all races combined in the United States are nearly three times higher than in Japan for leukemia, aleukemia, lymphosarcoma, and similar forms of cancer. In the case of Hodgkin's disease the overall American death rate is almost four times that of the Japanese. However, the difference between American non-whites and Japanese is not nearly as great. Among females it is exactly the same.

A pathologist from Tohoku University School of Medicine in Japan, Dr. Wakasa will try to determine whether these statistics reflect true differences in the characteristics and incidence of cancer involved, or are simply due to international variations in the medical terminology used.

He will analyze more than 1,000 cases of malignant lymphoma and Hodgkin's disease already collected in the California State Tumor Registry and evaluate new case material as sent to the registry by hospitals throughout the state. In the latter activity he will employ electron microscopy, tissue culture, and histopathology techniques.

Dr. Brown, formerly in the department of pediatrics at the University of Minnesota, will complete a two-year tour of medical duty in the U.S. Air Force before beginning his fellowship in the pediatrics department of the UCLA Medical School in June, 1967.

The fellowship grants are supported by income and principal of a \$2,000,000 legacy to the American Cancer Society's California division by the late Mrs. Irene B. Darnham of San Francisco.


