Symphony Opens Season Here Friday

Louis Palange will conduct the Beach Cities Symphony when the music group opens its 16th concert season Friday in the Mira Costa High School Auditorium.

There will be no admission charge for the 8 p.m. concert.

De Falla's "Three Corners Hat" will open the evening's program. The difficult, but colorful selection was selected for its unusual rhythmic patterns and rapid tempo. Palange said the number "is a challenge for any symphony."

LEO DAMIANI will hold the baton for the opening number. A noted conductor, Damiani is a specialist in the modern trend and "is at his best when working with de Falla compositions," Palange said.

Three other concerts are planned during the season. The symphony will present its annual Youth Concert Jan. 28, with a 15-year-old violinist as guest artist.

A TRIBUTE to the late Mario Lanza has been scheduled March 25. Guest artist for the concert will be tenor Jerry Treston, winner of the Mario Lanza Award. The final concert will be presented May 13 and will feature a complete Mozart symphony.
