

Assessing Officers Select New Leaders for Los Angeles Area

Al Villaseñor, chief of the Marine Division of the Los Angeles County Assessor's Department, has been elected new president of the local chapter of the International Association of Assessing Offi-

cers. Villaseñor had served as vice-president since the chapter was formed last Spring.

John Morrissey, chief of the real estate section of the Assessment Standards Division and former secretary, was elected vice-president; Marvin Blatt, chief of the Post Audit Division and former treasurer, is the new secretary; and Robert Mason, this year's National IAAO Donehoo Award winner, is the new treasurer.

Outgoing president, Assessor Phil Watson, turned over his gavel to Villaseñor with the announcement that the chapter membership had now reached a new high of 528.

The election was held at the recent chapter seminar at the Hacienda Motor Hotel in

San Pedro, attended by more than 200 members. Featured speakers were John Lyman, vice-president of Security Title Insurance Co. who discussed current practices in mortgage financing; Conrad C. Jamison, vice-president of Security First National Bank, who spoke on population, building and real estate trends in Los Angeles County; and Public Relations Consultant Larry Dysart, whose topic was "Communications."

Rounding out the program was a report on the Houston IAAO Conference, by Mason, and a summary of the highlights of the recent Conference of the State Association of County Assessors by Watson.

USC Christmas Program Planned

Three free public Christmas programs will be given in Bovard Auditorium at the University of Southern California at 8 p.m. on Dec. 14, 15 and 16, the USC Committee on Convocations and Special Events announced today. Admission will be only by ticket obtainable on request from the USC Special Events office.

A 13th century miracle play, "The Miracle of Theophile," by the French poet Rutebef, will be staged by USC drama students the first two nights.

Dr. Frank C. Baxter, professor emeritus of English, will resume his traditional Christmas readings on December 16 for the first time in four years.

The USC Chamber Singers conducted by Charles C. Hirt of 1318 Cordova Ave., Glendale, will also present a program of Christmas music from around the world on the first two nights.

USC Concert conducted by James H. Vail of 19404 S. Falway Ave., Gardena, will provide musical accompaniment for the miracle play,

which has been transposed from French into English by Mrs. Norma L. Goodrich of 1650 Ramona Ave., Glendale, assistant professor of French and comparative literature at USC.

Dr. Baxter, now "Reader in Residence" on the campus, read Christmas prose and poetry every December for 21 years until his retirement in 1961.

Dr. Baxter will read parts of "A Christmas Carol" by Charles Dickens; "Three Ghosts Came Riding By" by Walter de la Mare; "From Far

Away and Long Ago," a medieval carol; "The Oxen" by Thomas Hardy, and "A Christmas Spectacle" by Robert Benchley.

He will also read a poem written by an unknown British soldier during the battle of Tobruk in north Africa in World War II; and verses by G. K. Chesterton, J. B. Tabb, Lizette Woodworth Reese, Ogden Nash, and Dorothy Parker.

There will be caroling and a reception around a 25-foot Christmas tree in front of Bovard Auditorium after each program.
