- 1 stalk celery, minced

**'Heartful Carol' to Be Held at Hospital**

A Christmas gift decorated with Yuletide cheer, entwined with heart facts and wrapped with a royal proclamation will be presented to Torrance residents by the Heart Association's Southwestern Branch at its "Heartful Christmas Carol" program at Harbor General Hospital, Sunday.

Amidst Christmas carols and "hearthside heart information" one of eight local high school girls — including one from the Torrance area — will be proclaimed Branch Heart Princess at the hospital, 1000 W. Carson St.

**THE ANNOUNCEMENT** will be given in the hospital's assembly room, after guests hear some "hearthside heart facts."

Dr. William Bloomer, chief heart surgeon at Harbor General Hospital and a UCLA medical instructor, will discuss current cardiac surgery and his various heart research projects. Justin Brantiff, branch public education chairman, will explain the branch heart information projects and programs. Other heart messengers will tell how the Heart Association is helping to reduce the risk of heart attacks and strokes.

But the climax of the 2 p.m. event will occur when Louis S. Scibona, Torrance, branch Heart Princess chairman, will name the new 1965-66 Heart Princess.

Torrance will be represented by princess candidate, Kelly O'Leary, 21306 Payne Ave. The Carson High School junior became a candidate because of her own encounter with heart disorder. Through her mother's personal bout with heart problems and a heart attack last year, Kelly discovered how heart difficulties can affect a whole family.

**AT THE PROGRAM** there will be an empty chair for one Heart Princess candidate, Annette Yvonne Olsen, 927 East Fiat St. She, because of her own heart problem, will be in a hospital bed recovering from an open heart operation.

The Carson High School junior explained that the heart surgery earlier in the week will only allow her to wish the new Heart Princess the "best of luck." The blonde-haired contestant is suffering from a heart defect, "holes in her heart,"

which needed surgical correcting.

"Everyone is welcome to the Sunday afternoon program," Scibona explained. With the royal announcement, "hearthside heart information" and Christmas entertainment and "arols, there will be exhibits and demonstrations of life saving procedures and instruments used to help heart patients enjoy many Christmases-to-come.

For the younger set, "heart beats will become musical beats" when "Telstar," a musical group, and the "Sugar N' Spice," girl vocalists, provide Yuletide entertainment.
