Area Cases Increase Build-Up in Viet Nam Keeps Red Cross Busy

Red Cross services to members of the Armed Forces and their dependents are up 40 per cent over six months ago.

Mrs. Paul Sullivan of Palos Verdes Estates, who represents the Southern District of the Los Angeles Red Cross Chapter on the Service to Military Families Advisory Committee, credits the sudden caseload upsurge to the U. S. Military buildup in Viet Nam.

Red Cross locally, through three caseworkers at the Southern District Red Cross Service Center in San Pedro, and throughout the Los Angeles area and nationwide are experiencing the largest volume of activity on behalf of military families since the Korean war, according to Mrs. Sullivan.

DECLARING that volume goes up in proportion to military strength and activity, Mrs. Sullivan predicted a continuing increase in volume as the military continues to build up "and the absence of servicemen from home gets longer."

On duty in South Viet Nam, she says, are 70 American Red Cross field directors, who provide assistance with family and personal problems to servicemen in the field and act as a link with their families through Red Cross chapters in servicemen's home communities throughout the United States.

MRS. SULLIVAN said most emergency messages have been handled "with remarkable speed, despite heavy military communications traffic," explaining that Red Cross also uses military facilities.

A few inevitable delays have occurred in South Viet Nam, she reports. "Sometimes a unit moves so fast its hard to make swift contact with its personnel, while others in more isolated areas can only be reached by air transportation, which is in short supply for this purpose."

DURING October, she said, 41,203 Red Cross messages were transmitted between the United States and off-continent points, concerning personal and family problems of servicemen.

Of this number, 1,192 messages were transmitted on behalf of service families in Los Angeles and Orange Counties, she said.

The current "hard core" Red Cross caseload in the two counties averages 500 per month "with an average of 375 families per month receiving financial assistance to help with family emergencies."
