

# El Camino Sets Spring Deadline

Persons interested in attending El Camino College during the spring semester are encouraged to contact the registration office as early as possible in January to make arrangements for registration, placement testing, and counseling.

The registration office is open daily Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. until 9 p.m. and on Friday from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

Placement tests, if required, must be completed five days prior to registration. Registration will be held Feb. 2, 3, and 4 in the Communications Center.

El Camino will admit graduates of any high school or applicants who are 16 years of age or older who can meet the residence requirements. A district boundary map may be obtained in the registration office.

Students must file transcripts of high school and previous college credit prior to registration and be prepared to pay a student fee of \$3 at the time of registration.

For out-of-state residents, there will be a nonresident tuition fee of \$10.30 per unit with a maximum charge of \$151.50 at the time of registration.

Spring semester classes begin Monday, Feb. 7.

# Strip Area Road Work Authorized

Improvement of a segment of Normandie Avenue in the Shoestring Strip territory east of Torrance to provide better access to a school and residential areas was authorized today by the Los Angeles Board of Public Works.

District Councilman John S. Gibson Jr. said the Board of Public Works will open bids on Jan. 12 and probably will award the construction contract a short time later.

The plans for this project call for removing the existing substandard 20-foot-wide rock and oil pavement in the west roadway of Normandie Avenue between Torrance Boulevard and 212th Street and replacing it with a 28-foot-wide asphaltic concrete roadway.

Other construction features include installing concrete curb and gutter along the easterly side of the roadway and street lights at the 209th Street and the 211th Street intersections with Normandie Avenue.

Councilman Gibson said the proposed improvement will provide improved access to the Halldale Avenue Elementary School, facilitate access to many residential neighborhoods in the area, complete the west roadway improvements between Torrance Boulevard and Carson Street, improve drainage in the west roadway, and reduce street maintenance costs.
