Susol, 21, a helicopter maintenance specialist, entered the Army in June of this year, completed basic training at Fort Ord, Calif., and was last assigned at Fort Rucker, Ala.

Seaman Apprentice William R. White, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. Chester W. White of 1445 W. 224th St., is scheduled to return to Long Beach aboard the ocean-going minesweeper USS Excel, after an eight-month deployment to the Western Pacific.

While operating with the Seventh Fleet, Excel participated in patrol operations in the waters off the coast of Viet Nam. The operation, called "Market Time," is conducted on a continuing basis to keep arms and supplies from being smuggled into Viet Nam by water.

She also participated in a joint U.S.-Philippine minesweeping exercise. Excel is designed to operate in shallow water, and detect and disarm or destroy enemy mines.

America, the Navy's newest attack carrier, is armed with surface-to-air "Terrier" guided missiles and the latest in Navel jet aircraft. She is part of an Attack Carrier Striking Force, consisting of two large carriers, two guided missile cruisers and about 16 destroyers.

First Loan Granted in New Center

Occidental Life Insurance Co. of California has made a 20-year, \$800,000 loan to Watson Land Co. for construction at the Watson Industrial Center in the Dominguez area.

Proceeds of the loan will be used by Watson to finance building of 62,000 square feet of display rooms and sales-and-service facilities for Cormier Chevrolet Co., which has leased 10 acres at the Center along the south side of the San Diego Freeway.

Occidental's is the first loan for construction at the Center, according to Albert E. Adams, secretary of Watson Land Co. "The participation of a lending institution of Occidental's stature, on mutually favorable terms, is both encouraging and gratifying to us," Adams said.

The Watson Center, which includes 750 acres in the Dominguez area, is a projected \$175,000,000 industrial complex. Off-site development on approximately half of the project has been completed.
