

Fourth Demo Joins Race For New Senate Vacancy

Harold W. Garvin, a professor of political science at Harbor College, today became the fourth Democrat to enter the race for State Senator from the new 32nd District.

Garvin, 40, pledged "active, creative, courageous leadership to deal effectively with the broad array of urban problems our district faces."

His main interest, Garvin declared, is to "bring the new power our area will have in the State Senate to bear for better education and recreation, better transportation and smog control, more jobs, and tax revision—particularly lowering our excessive property taxes."

GARVIN WAS raised in Gardena and now makes his home in San Pedro with his wife, Frances, and three children, Linda, 17, Beth Ann, 12, and Buzzy, 6.

He has served three terms as president of the 17th Congressional District Democratic Council and is a past president of the 68th Assembly District Democratic Council. Garvin also has been active in the work of the Harbor Area Democratic Club and the San Pedro Democratic Club.

IN 1958, the new candidate was a research specialist for Governor Edmund G. Brown's

first campaign for governor and has served as a campaign advisor to Congressman Cecil King, Assemblyman Clayton Dills, and Assemblyman Vincent Thomas.

"My decision to run was made only after many discussions with political leaders throughout the district and several conversations with Assemblyman Clayton Dills," Garvin said. "It will be my intention to work with Assemblyman Dills so that together we can bring to our area the needed improvements that our state government can and must provide."
