## Hospital Installs Chief, Talks About New Facility

Installation of new medical staff officers and organization of a citizens hospital committee got Torrance Memorial Hospital off to what its officers predict will be a pivotal year for the 40-year-old community hospital.

John W. Tippin, M.D., was installed as chief of the medical staff at a recent dinner at the Palos Verdes Golf Club. He succeeded Richard A. Sullivan, M.D., who was recognized for his outstanding service during the year, and for "the leadership which he provided not only in his direction of all medical staff activities but in his interest in establishing an extensive medical facility for the residents of Torrance and the South Bay area."

Dr. Tippin, M.D., pointed out that the hospital belongs to the community and can attain its goal of providing the best possible patient care "only if it has complete community understanding, cooperation,

ORGANIZATION of the expansion committee came at the invitation of Mrs. Doris S. Woolley, chairman of the hospital's board of directors. Mrs. Woolley told the doctors and community leaders at the first meeting that preliminary discussions had shown a strong community support for expansion of the hospital on a new site to provide a 250-bed hospital with a master plan permitting expansion to a 500-bed facility.

### Symposium Scheduled

Dr. Tippin told the group that Torrance has an outstanding group of physicians and surgeons trained in the various specialties and that such a new hospital would provide the necessary diagnostic and therapeutic services so that any procedure could be carried out in the community, eliminating the need to go elsewhere for specialized care.

"New Horizons in Miracles" will be the theme of a symposium on management of neurologically handicapped children to be held in Anaheim Saturday, Feb. 12.

The symposium is sponsored by the California Association for Neurologically Handicapped Children (CANHC). Featured speaker will be Dr. Sam Clements from the University of Arkansas Medical Center's Child Guidance Clinic.

MRS. WOOLLEY said the proposed hospital would include all services including medical, surgical, pediatrics, geriatrics, obstetrical, emergency, clinics, rehabilitation facilities, and others.

## 'Macbeth' To Play At BMHS

and "Compulsion." Others in the cast include Howard Chamberlain as Banquo and Bradford Sullivan as Macduff.
