Three Area Men Win Silver Beaver Award

Three Torrance men were among 22 community leaders honored by the Los Angeles Area Council of the Boy Scouts of America last week during the annual Silver Beaver Awards dinner.

The 22 men have contributed a total of 339 years to the Boy Scouts of America. They were recognized at the 51st annual Silver Beaver Awards.

The Silver Beaver is the highest award a Boy Scout Council can confer on an adult volunteer. Qualifications include at least five years of continuous service to Scouting.

THE NEW winners include James Eckhart, 5315 Linda Drive; Richard Mars, 19700 S. Figueroa St., and B. B. Neel, 19109 S. Figueroa St.

Eckhart has been active in Scouting since he became a member of the pack committee for Cub Scout Pack 877C in 1955. 


