Prenatal Classes Opening Tonight in Area Hospital

A "Prenatal Course for Future Mothers" will be offered next week by obstetric nurses at South Bay Hospital, Redondo Beach, it was announced by Mrs. Genevieve Tigges, R.N., obstetrics department supervisor.

The three-night course is designed to help mothers solve the practical problems of comfort and care of themselves and their babies before and after the baby's birth, Mrs. Tigges said.

Instructors will be nurses in the hospital's delivery, nursery, and post-birth patient areas. Course content has been approved by hospital staff doctors.

First meeting of the class will be at 7:30 this evening in the hospital cafeteria, 514 N. Prospect Ave., Redondo Beach. Succeeding classes will meet on the following Wednesdays at the hospital.

DOROTHY DIGS in the garden

Some borers are becoming more and more of a pest to many trees. It is essential to check now and see if there are any indications of borers in your favorite shade or fruit trees.


If there are any holes in the bark indicating borer attacks last season, treat the ground area beneath the tree with an ethylene dichloride borer solution. Do it now while the borers are still hibernating in the soil at the base of the tree. Follow directions making sure the soil is well watered before treatment.

An ounce of work now will prevent much damage later in the season.
