Aisensohn Will Seek Court Post

Superior Court Commissioner David J. Aisensohn has announced he will seek office this year as a Judge of the Municipal Court in the Los Angeles Judicial District.

Aisensohn, 41, said he decided to seek election to the bench "because I feel that due to my background, I can make a significant contribution to the efficient administration of justice in this district."

He was elected a commissioner of the Superior Court in July, 1962, by judges at that court. He has been assigned to the Domestic Relations, Civic Trial, Law and Motion, and Pretrial Departments, sitting as a Judge pro Tempore.

Aisensohn served six years as an assistant district attorney in Los Angeles currently and is a member of the Law Faculty at San Fernando State College. He has lectured at the Los Angeles Police Academy and has presided over practice court sessions in the University of Southern California School of Law.

He was born in New York City, but has lived in Southern California since he was 11 years old. Aisensohn was graduated from Fairfax High School in Los Angeles and the University of California at Los Angeles. He earned his law degree at Southwestern University.

During World War II, Aisensohn served in the Pacific Theater in the Army Air Corps. He and his wife reside in Granada Hills with their three children.
