Hothouse Rhubarb Spring Reminder

On the market now is Washington Hothouse Rhubarb, bright pink, succulent and tender, ready for wonderful rhubarb pies and sauce and reminding everyone that Spring is on the way.

Because it is grown quickly, forced, under hot house conditions, Washington Hothouse rhubarb is entirely different from field grown rhubarb. It is much milder, more tender and delicious in flavor. It's so crisp you need not peel it. It breaks like a young snapbean.

And it can be cut up raw, packaged, put in a freezer and enjoyed all year long.

- RHUBARB CHIFFON TARTS**
- Pastry mix for 2-crust pie
 - 2 cup chopped Washington Hothouse rhubarb
 - 1/2 cup sugar
 - 2 tbs. orange juice
 - 1/2 tsp. grated orange peel
 - 1 env. unflavored gelatin
 - 2 tbs. water
 - 3 eggs separated
 - Dash salt
 - 1/4 cup sugar
 - Whipped cream

Prepare pastry mix according to directions on package. Place in 7 to 9 tart pans (depending on size). Bake and cool. Bring rhubarb, 1/2 cup sugar and orange juice to boil. Simmer until rhubarb is soft. Add orange peel. Soften gelatin in water. Add gelatin to hot rhubarb; stir until dissolved. Mix small amount of mixture with egg yolks. Return to pan and simmer several minutes stirring constantly, until mixture

coats spoon. Chill until thick. Beat egg whites until stiff, gradually beating in 1/4 cup sugar. Fold into gelatin mixture. Spoon into tart shells. Chill until firm. Garnish with whipped cream. Makes 7 to 9 tarts.

Sift dry ingredients together. Cut in shortening. Add beer and stir until dough is soft. Knead. Roll 1/2 inch thick. Bake 10 to 15 minutes at 450 degrees.

STUFFED SHRIMP APPETIZERS

- 3 lbs. large shrimp, shelled, deveined
- 1 3-oz. pkg. cream cheese
- 1 3-oz. pkg. bleu cheese
- 1/2 cup beer
- 1/4 cup minced parsley

Roll shrimp 3 to 5 minutes. Drain, chill, beat cheese together, add beer slowly. Slip shrimp part way on vein side and stuff. Roll in parsley. Makes 4 dozen.
