Taft-Hartley Debate Draws Most Mail for Congressman

Congressman Alphonzo Bell (R-28th District) today said his heaviest mail during January asked him to oppose efforts to repeal Section 14(b) of the Taft-Hartley Act.

The second request made most often, he added, was to support efforts to repeal the section.

Other subjects which drew heavy mail to his Washington offices, Bell said, were:

- Urge extension of U. S. military activity in Southeast Asia.
- Criticize administration of the federal anti-poverty program.
- Express concern about news management in Vietnam.
- Urge negotiated settlement of the war in Southeast Asia.
- Advocate passage of the "Cold War" G. I. Bill of Rights.
- Criticize continued United States involvement in the Dominican Republic.
- Express concern about the crime rate in the United States.

Plans Shown for Area's Newest Shopping Center

AK-mart department store and Von's Market will form the nucleus of the Southwest area's newest complete shopping center, located adjacent to the Harbor Freeway at the corner of Sepulveda Boulevard and Vermont Avenue, developer Robert Barclay announced today.

Plans for the center, which will have parking for 700 cars, were previewed at a luncheon attended by principals of the major tenants, construction and architecture firms, and the developers, Barclay-Hollander-Curci and R. A. Watt, Inc.

The 77,000-square-foot K-mart building will include complete department store facilities in addition to an automotive center and all seasons garden shop. The contemporary design store, one of 30 currently planned for Southern California, is scheduled to open in mid-October, according to regional manager W. H. Teninga. Construction superintendent is G. W. Anderson.

In addition to the major tenants, four service stores—a barber shop, laundromat, beauty shop, and dry cleaners—will be joined by a coffee-donut shop.

Ernest W. Hahn, Inc., one of the nation's largest shopping center builders, will serve as general contractor with Lloyd Powell assigned as project director, according to Ernest W. Hahn, president.

THE ARCHITECTURAL firm of Ainsworth and McClellan has been selected to design the plans and serve as supervising architects. Bob McClellan will supervise the project.

Shopping center broker Tom Trump represented all parties during the negotiations. Milton Gordon, president of Mortgage Marketing Service Co., Inc., arranged for the financing.

Also attending the announcement luncheon were Barclay-Hollander-Curci vice president Richard Barclay, attorney Dennis G. Harkavy and Al Cohen. Joining president Ray Watt, were R. A. Watt, Inc., officials executive vice president Bill Watt, vice president - land acquisition John Grindle, and director of public relations Hank Litten.
