



You'd like to do something for freedom, but you don't know where to start?

VOTE in the primaries as well as the general elections. Know the propositions, too.




VISIT a historical shrine with your kids. Let them see and feel the roots of freedom.




EXPLAIN who the men on your money are to your kids. It's a fascinating way to get history across.
