

Bids Opened For Storm Drain Bonds



Out of a total of 10 bids received so far on the purchase of the initial \$15 million block of storm drain bonds, the highest offer was submitted by Bank of America at a total interest rate of 2.33 per cent, according to the Board of Supervisors.

Sale of the bonds will provide funds for start of construction on the \$275 million program approved last November by county voters.

The program calls for construction of 267 projects by the County Flood District. All construction will be handled by private contractors on a competitive bidding basis.


Plans for the various drain projects will be prepared by the cities where they are to be located and submitted to the district for review and advertising of bids.

DANCE


