





Enrollment Open for Adult School Courses

Registration for adult education courses in Torrance will be accepted in classes for beginners, horticultural until Feb. 19, Raymond Collins, adult school principal, has announced. Classes for the spring semester began Monday evening.

New courses being offered this spring include Business English, business machines, public speaking, and physical fitness for men.

The physical fitness course, based on a program recommended by the late President Kennedy's Council on Physical Fitness, is taught at the Torrance High gymnasium from 7 to 9 p.m. each Tuesday and Thursday.

AN ADDITIONAL section of the oil painting course, taught at South High, has been opened because of heavy enrollment. The new section is meeting each Wednesday from 7 to 9:30 p.m.

Openings are still available in the following classes: electronics, circuitry and schematics, drafting, basic sewing and wood shop, all of which meet at North High. South

High classes still open include: drawing and painting for beginners, horticultural landscaping, physical fitness for women, beginning shorthand, and typing.

Torrance High classes which have space are: Algebra I, bookkeeping II, chemistry, drawing and painting for beginners, economics, investments and securities, and general mathematics.

DAYTIME openings are available in the Cooperative Nursery class at McMaster Park. The class meets from 9 a.m. until noon Thursdays.
