Chamber of Commerce Week Observance Set

Residents of Torrance will join with others throughout the country in observance of Chamber of Commerce Week, April 4-10, it was announced today by Arthur L. Reeves, president, who is serving as chairman for the local phase of the nationwide program.

Gov. Edmund G. "Pat" Brown recently issued an official proclamation designating the observance in recognition of the important part chambers play in the economic, social and cultural development of the state.

Chamber of Commerce Week is being sponsored locally by the Torrance Chamber of Commerce, Reeves announced, while the nationwide effort is being coordinated by American Chamber

of Commerce Executives, the national management society for Chamber executives. It is dedicated to improving executive efficiency, establishing and maintaining ethical standards and working toward the ultimate aim of community improvement throughout the United States by continually raising the caliber of Chamber executive performance.

"CHAMBER OF Commerce Week is the second such observance of its kind ever held nationally," Reeves said. Purposes for Chamber of Commerce Week, Reeves pointed out are:

- To give recognition to the Chamber's staff and to the volunteer leaders for their constructive participation in community affairs.
- To further strengthen relations with organizations and agencies in our community.

Residents Circulate Petition

A petition seeking street improvements in the vicinity of Aliene Avenue and 255th Street is now being circulated in the neighborhood.

The petition asks the Lomita City Council to secure the necessary right-of-way for and the installation of curbs, gutters, walk returns, driveways, and sanitary sewers.

The petition must be signed by persons representing at least 60 per cent of the assessed valuation of the property in the area. If the construction is ordered by the council following hearings, the costs—estimated to be \$28,650—would be borne by the benefiting property owners.
