

Marymount Will Hold Science Day Saturday

Principal speakers at the annual Marymount College High School Science Day Saturday will be Dr. Simon George of the physics department of California State College at Long Beach and John Prescott, curator of fish at Marineland of the Pacific.

Dr. George will discuss "What Spectra Inform Us About Atoms" while Prescott will outline his work, especially with whales and dolphins, in "Sonar Research at the Oceanarium." Two motion pictures, "Similarities in Wave Behavior" and "The Bell Solar Battery," will also be shown.


In charge of the four-hour meeting which begins at 1:30 p.m. is Sister William, RSHM, who cordially invites all high school students to expand their knowledge of wave motion as found in their physics, biology and chemistry classes by participating in the program.

Students will view demonstrations of spectroscopy, X-ray diffraction, cloud chamber, solar energy, photoelectric effect, microwave optics, lasers and ultrasonics through new equipment provided by the Van Waters & Rogers, and Central Scientific Companies.

FOLLOWING the talks presented by the scientists students will be invited to ask questions about work in wave motion research and to use the new equipment themselves, including the laser.

"One of the important points of the afternoon will be to show the role of one phenomenon in all the sciences, biological and physical," says Sister William. "We will display the implications of the wave theory in these sciences."

All meetings will be held in the Science Building on the Marymount campus, and there is no fee for the program which concludes at 4:30 p.m.






