

Follow Basic Rules to Brew Coffee

Clean coffee pot with coffee maker cleaner once a week. Between times, rinse pot with hot water; wipe with soft towel. Never use soap, detergent or scouring pad.



To have coffee fresh, buy it in the size which will be used in one week. Serve coffee freshly brewed; never re-heated or boiled.

Measure coffee and cold water exactly. Two level measuring tablespoons of coffee make one six-ounce cup of coffee.

- 3/4 cup Burgundy
- 2 tbs. tomato sauce

Melt butter in heavy skillet. Sauté onion, carrots, and mushrooms about 10 minutes. Add defrosted tips and tomato sauce, simmer 10 minutes. Add wine and heat. Serve on bed of white rice.



PAIR PASTRY WITH TEA

Tender little rectangles of flaky tender pastry, filled with boysenberry jam and sprinkled with powdered sugar, provide perfect accompaniment for afternoon tea. Prepare pastry recipe for two nine-inch pies. Roll out half the dough on floured board. Cut into even squares. Put teaspoon jam in center of each square. Moisten edges and seal each side together and close at top. Bake at 425 degrees for 20 minutes or until brown and pastry is done. Remove from oven and sprinkle with powdered sugar. Serve hot or cold.
